Exclusion Date

The State of Illinois law states that students will be excluded from school beginning October 15 until all "medical" requirements are met and reports are turned into the school. This includes: physical exams and up to date immunization records. If you know your student is missing something, please contact your child's doctor now to make your appointment. **LETTERS WENT HOME THIS WEEK.** If your student is missing exams or immunizations, you need to contact the school office ASAP. I will grant a 3 day extension because notices were not sent out early; however, students will be excluded after Wednesday if you have not communicated and/or turned in missing items.

Birth Certificates

Birth certificates must be on file for every student. While a missing certificate is not grounds for exclusion, the Illinois State Police must be contacted regarding any student with a missing birth certificate. This is a state law and cannot be waived. This notification will take place on Wednesday, October 19.

First Quarter Ends - Parent/Teacher Conferences Upcoming

First quarter ends today. Teachers will be scheduling conferences beginning next week. This conference is a requirement. It's a good time to ask questions and make sure you and your child are on the same page with the teacher and his/her expectations.

Dress Code

The end of the first quarter brings an end to shorts/bare legs. Boys must wear uniform pants during the second and third quarters. Girls may wear uniform shirts or dresses but must have tights on with them. Otherwise, uniform pants are required.
