

### First Quarter Ends

It's hard to believe that our first quarter will end next Friday already. Be sure to check your child's grade/assignment information in your parent portal. Follow up on missing assignments with your child and reach out to the teacher if you have questions.

### Dress Code

The end of the first quarter also brings an end to shorts/bare legs. Boys must wear uniform pants during the second and third quarters. Girls may wear uniform shirts or dresses but must have tights on with them. Otherwise, uniform pants are required.

### Outdoor Activities

Students will continue to enjoy outdoor activities as the temps drop. Please be sure that students bring or wear appropriate clothing for the weather and bring a jacket. Remember that all articles of clothing must follow the dress code. This includes outerwear.

### B.A.T.

BAT packs were sent home on Monday. **Make sure students bring back pledge/donation sheets on Wednesday next week to collect their prize on Friday.** The 4th Annual Bowl-A-Thon will be taking place on Wednesday, October 26. This event is held during our week-long celebration of Lutheran Schools. This is the single largest fundraiser that we hold, and we rely on it to help keep our tuition rates as low as possible by offsetting operating expenses. We are asking families to reach out to local businesses, friends, and family to support the school through a fun and activity based event for the students.

**IMPORTANT:** Every Wednesday, the donation/pledge form and money will be turned in to the school. Every Friday, prizes will be awarded. Every \$50 turned in will earn your student a prize. If the school hits its \$6,000 goal, the entire student body will enjoy a partial afternoon "off" (still in-school). If the school hits the \$10,000 mark, the student body will receive a full "Day-of-Play" (to be scheduled and will occur during a regular school day). The details of this event are being kept a secret. The closer they get, the more they will know.

### Exclusion Date

The State of Illinois law states that students will be excluded from school beginning October 15 until all "medical" requirements are met and reports are turned into the school. This includes: physical exams and up to date immunization records. If you know your student is missing something, please contact your child's doctor now to make your appointment.
