Reminder: Please make sure you are familiar with the details below.

An important change to our policy regarding late arrivals (not tardy), early pick up, and returning to school midday was initiated beginning Monday, March 6.

If your child will arrive late from an appointment or leave mid-day, you will need to contact your teacher (as always) and <u>also the office ahead of time</u>. Your child will be ready for pick up <u>in the school office at the designated time</u>. It is unlikely that your child will be ready earlier than requested. If your child is arriving late or returning, you will <u>bring him/her into</u> the school office with a note, and the office staff will get them to class.

Students should not be leaving early unless it is absolutely necessary. Upon return, a note will be necessary even if it is the next day. Also, notice must be given if you intend to remove your child, except in cases of an emergency. Students and teachers have routines and activities all day, everyday and need time to plan for disruptions.
